Part I Teams will:

- strengthen your understanding and implementation of the framework and process of Integrated Comprehensive Systems for Equity;
- engage in plentiful team time throughout the event to dive into a deep equity analysis of your setting;
- complete an Equity Action Plan for your school, district, region, or state to advance equity systems change for all.

Part II Teams will:

- review the implementation and next steps of Cornerstones 1 and 2 in your schools and districts;
- engage in deep, practical application of Co-Plan to Co-Serve to Co-Learn.

For District and School Leadership Teams, state and regional teams, professional associations, non-profit and for-profit organizations, city/county governments, and those in higher education.

Each School/District Team should include 8-10 people.

The Institutes will be held virtually, via synchronous online learning with small group and large group work. As co-presenters, Dr. Elise Frattura and Dr. Colleen Capper bring a combined history of over 65 years of distance learning experience.
